Pre-Hopeful Jumpers - Open to horses and ponies. Fences 2'6"

7. Pre-Hopefuls Jumpers Warm Up

Hopeful Jumper - Open to horses and Ponies. Fences 2'9".

Low Schooling Jumper -Open to horses and ponies. Fences 3' – 3'3"

High Schooling Jumper - Open to horses and ponies. Fence 3'6" – 3'9"

Go Go Jumpers - Open to horses and ponies. Fence 4' – 4'3"

19. Go Go Jumpers Warm Up

GENERAL INFORMATION

-No horses, ponies on the course prior to start time.

-Riders may walk the course from 7 A.M. until show time.

-45 second rule will be in effect for every division.

This means if you are not in the ring within 45 seconds of being called you will be disqualified.

Table II, Sec. 2 (b) "Timed First Jump Off"

The first round and jump off if any, are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. If the competitor has gone clean in the first round, the competitor will, without leaving the ring, upon an audible signal, commence the designated jump off course. Anyone leaving the ring before the jump-off will be considered to have retired.

Table II, Sec. 2 (c) "Power and Speed"

The first round and jump off if any, are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed if any. If a competitor has gone clean in the first round, they will, upon crossing the finish line, commence the designated jump off course. Time starts as the horse crosses the finish line for the initial course. Ties will be broken by time in the first round.
