The jumping course consists of both show jumps and cross country fences set on varied terrain. There will be 12 to 22 jumping efforts that may include water, ditches, and banks as well as the standard portable jumps. The Eventing Derby will follow the USEA rules for combined tests as closely as possible. This will be an excellent opportunity for riders of all disciplines to school their horses in a user friendly environment.

Eventing Derby General Information

- 1. **All riders should arrive early enough to walk their courses.** Once the Jumping Phase has begun, course walks will only be allowed during the breaks between divisions.
- 2. All ride times are tentative. Organizers reserve the right to change ride times. Listen for announcements and check for Notices at Show Office. Dressage will take place in the morning. Jumping phase will start after all dressage tests are completed.
- 3. Two riders may ride the same horse in two different divisions.
- 5. **Late Entries:** Entries received after the closing date may not be accepted, or may be placed on a waiting list or charged \$25.00 late fee. Please check with Show Secretary regarding acceptance of late entries.
- 6. **Refunds:** Before closing date, minus a \$25.00 administrative fee. After closing date, refund less \$25.00 administrative fee ONLY if place can be filled from waiting list. Otherwise, no refunds.
- 8. All Dogs Must Be Leashed at All Times.

Competition Rules:

- 1. **The Dressage Phase** will be scored on a penalty point basis; as in Eventing, the competitor with the lowest score will win that division of the competition.
- 2. Reading of Tests: The Eventing dressage test must be executed from memory, except those riding in Intro A, B or C, with no additional penalties.
- 3. Arena Size: Dressage tests will be ridden in a small (20x40m) arena).
- 4. Show attire: optional. Must wear protective Helmet, boots with a heel.

Eliminations: Please refer to the current USEA/USEF Rules for Eventing.

Errors or deviations from the prescribed course are penalized as follows:

Competition Rules: Show Jumping (will be combined with Cross Country penalties)

- 5. This competition will be conducted under the rules and regulations contained herein and will conform to USEA/USEF rules as applicable
- 6. The Jumping Phase rules and scoring will conform to the current USEA/USEF Rules for Show Jumping.
- 7. A horse may not be entered in more than two (2) divisions for jumping. A horse may be shared by a rider in a different division.
- 8. Jumping Phase Dress and Saddlery: USEA/USEF Rules for Cross-Country apply, including protective vests, helmets with harness and **USEA medical armbands**. USEA regulations for safety equipment will be required.
- 9. Errors or deviations from the prescribed course are penalized as follows:

First disobedience	4 penalties
Second disobedience	8 penalties
Third disobedience on course, all refusals going forward will receive 16 penalties per refusal	16 penalties, move onto next jump
Knockdown	4 penalties
Fall of competitor or horse	Elimination
Error of course not rectified	Elimination

Whenever horses are tied in the final classification, the horse with the least number of faults (jumping) in the Jumping phase shall be placed first. If still tied, the best score of the collective marks of the Dressage shall prevail. If still tied, placing's and awards are to be duplicated.

RESTRICTIONS ON SCHOOLING HORSES. It is forbidden, under penalty of disqualification, for anyone other than the competitor who will ride the horse in the competition to school the horse during the competition.
