GENERAL INFORMATION

-ALL participants MUST park down by show barns- NOT by MAIN barn.
-No horses, ponies on the course prior to start time.
-Riders may walk the course from 7 A.M. until show time.
-Same Rider/Horse Combo from classes 1-6 may NOT cross into Ring 2
-Ring 2 will start after Ring 1 finishes BUT NOT before 11am

Table II, Sec. 2 (b) "Timed First Jump Off"

The first round and jump off if any, are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. If the competitor has gone clean in the first round, the competitor will, without leaving the ring, upon an audible signal, commence the designated jump off course. Anyone leaving the ring before the jump-off will be considered to have retired.

Table II, Sec. 2 (c) "Power and Speed"

The first part of the course must be jumped clean - no faults. IF clear then time starts as the horse crosses the designated line for the second "speed" portion of the course.

Derby Cross Class

A jump course made up with a combination of show jumps and cross country fences. Course will be in a fenced arena and in an open area. Scored same as Optimum Time.

Optimum Time

A course of jumps with time closest to optimum time without going over. Clear rounds awarded first that have not gone over- then awards awarded by the least amount of faults.
