Safety vest required for cross country course. Medical armbands in accordance with USEA EV114.1No standing martingales. Whips allowed. Dressage legal bits only! Consult USEA/USDF rulebook for current legal issues. THERE HAVE

Dogs: Prefer that they are left at home. Friendly dogs on a leash that is attached to a

human are allowed. Incessant barkers will be asked to leave. Dog impound fee

for loose dogs \$50.

Stabling: \$75 day/night or \$100 for the weekend

Grounds Fee: \$25/day (if not stabled)

Shavings: \$10 per bag Tack stalls: \$50 each

RV hookups: \$100 weekend

Stabling from Friday @ 2pm through Sunday @ 4pm

Schooling: XC Schooling: \$25 if competing or \$50 if NOT competing Sunday until 3pm

(please make out as a separate check to SEDA)

Dressage competition arena schooling available 12-3:30pm Friday depending on

weather/arena conditions. A grounds fee of \$25 will be assessed

if not stabling.

Prizes: Ribbons for CT, HT, & XCT: 1st through 6th place in each division

Ribbons for Dressage: Ribbons 1st through 6th place plus High Point Champion

and Reserve for Open, AA and Junior.

Entries: HT: \$175 CT: \$150 XCT: \$150 X-TRA ROUNDS (XC or Stadium) \$35

Dressage: \$35/class (\$40 for late entries provided there is room in the schedule)

Office Fee: \$20/entry (for either compete or non-compete)

Same horse may be shown in two different divisions (either HT/CT/XCT) with different riders, but you must fill out separate entry form for each horse and rider combination. Late and/or incomplete entries AND/OR any change to entry will be charged \$50 – **no exceptions!** AND may be subject to a wait list if entries

warrant.
